Step 5: Introduce the <u>FLOSS</u> / FSZL Rule

One of the keys to successful phonics learning and ultimately reading and spelling is to learn the various rules and nuances of phonics. One useful rule is known as the <u>FLOSS</u> or FSZL Rule. Kids love to play games and teaching the various rules should become like a game.

FLOSS / FSZL Rule

RULE: When f//l//s/ or /z/ is heard after a <u>short vowel</u> at the end of a one-syllable word, it is usually spelled with a double ff, ll, ss, or zz. Of course, there are exceptions such as bus and quiz.
